Committee Name:

The committee shall be known as the SPHPM Research Governance Committee.

Purpose:

To support researchers at the School of Public Health and Preventive Medicine (SPHPM) in the conduct of high quality research.

Objectives:

- 1. To ensure that accepted **procedures** are in place to meet ethical principles of good research practice. This will be achieved by:
 - a. keeping up to date with relevant laws and regulations and principles of risk management standards, guidelines and/or policies for conducting research
 - b. ensuring all staff receive an induction when they join SPHPM
 - c. ensuring that all new staff receive a copy of the Guide to Good Research Practice
 - d. ensuring that all studies conduct an annual self audit
- 2. To **improve** Good Research Practice in SPHPM. This will be achieved by:
 - a. evaluating the research governance framework that is in place
- 3. To oversee and facilitate **education** regarding the pertinent standards, guidelines and/or policies. This will be achieved by:
 - a. information for staff who may have questions regarding the conduct of research
 - b. education (in the form of short courses) in the conduct of clinical research
- 4. To monitor oversee and facilitate **compliance** with the pertinent standards, guidelines and/or policies.
 - a. auditing research projects
 - b. ensuring that all studies conduct an annual self audit
- 5. To make **recommendations** to the SPHPM Executive or other appropriate bodies in relation to matters under the purview of this committee.
