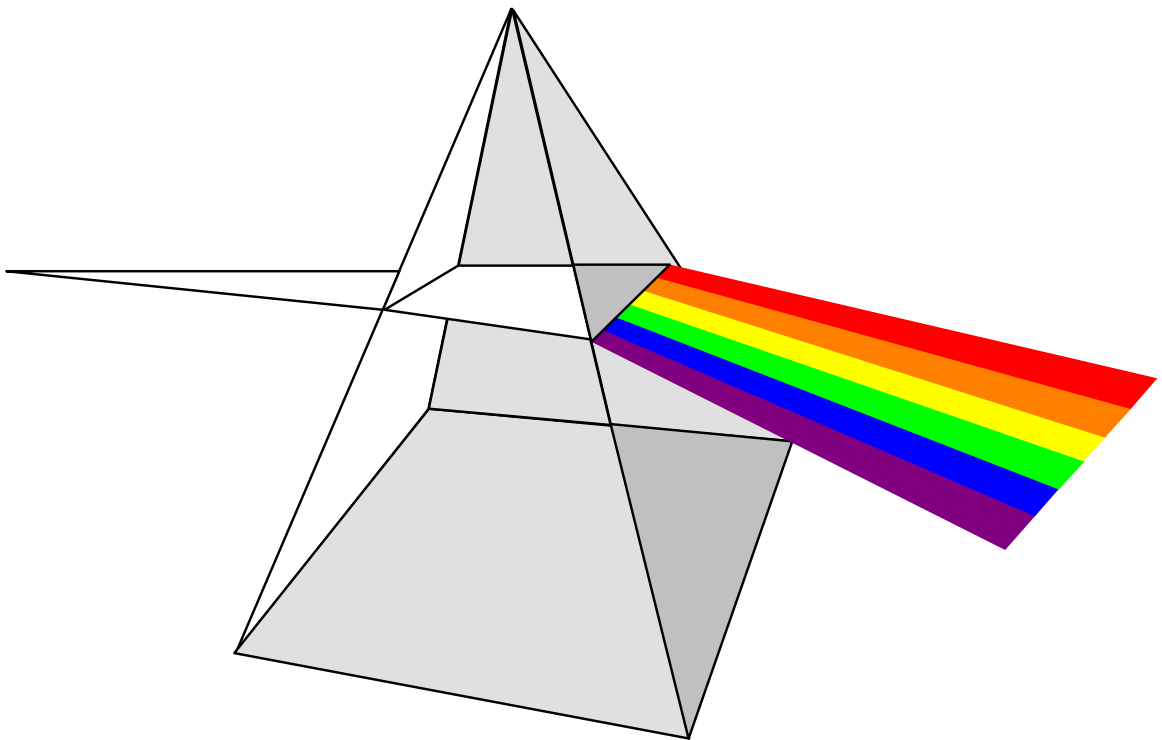


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AUTISM ASSESSMENTS AT EASTERN HEALTH CAMHS

Eastern Health CAMHS has a tertiary referral team for autism assessments and an educational program for community professionals who conduct autism assessments.

The Eastern Health CAMHS Autism Team does not provide on going support for children with autism and recommends that all children with a major developmental difficult have a paediatrician/child psychiatrist.

The Eastern Health CAMHS Autism Team is happy to provide secondary consultation to the paediatrician/child psychiatrist .

The Eastern Health CAMHS Autism Team is based at Box Hill and comprises a paediatrician, psychologist, speech pathologist and occupational therapist. The team accepts cases if they have had assessments within the community or CAMHS and there is still a question about the diagnosis of autism.

The Victorian Department of Education has legislated that a paediatrician or a child psychiatrist can make the diagnosis of autism together with a speech pathologist and a psychologist. All children should have a full audiology assessment. Occupational therapy and educational assessments are valuable but not essential for diagnosis for integration support at a State School.

A team diagnosis is NOT needed to access early childhood intervention services. (but may be needed for the new Federal initiative once it is establishe with Autism Victoria)

A team assessment for integration funding at school can take place prior to school entry using the staff at the early childhood intervention service and/or the Education Department from the future school with the child's paediatrician or psychiatrist.

This booklet identifies the public and private professionals within the community who can work as teams or individuals to assess a child for autism.

There are publicly funded teams of psychologists and speech pathologists who work closely with private paediatricians and psychiatrists. The teams identified are:

- Illoura ECIP in Knox for local children
- Specialist Children's Services - Inner and Outer teams
- Maroondah and Whitehorse Community Health Centres
- Department of Education
- Irabina Childhood Autism Services can provide private speech and psychology assessments at a reduced cost or a team assessment as part of the child's early childhood intervention package.

There are private psychologists and speech pathologists who also have close working relationships with paediatricians and psychiatrists in their locality.

If a child is referred to Eastern Health CAMHS who has not had any professional involvement they are asked to obtain a GP referral to one of the interested paediatricians/child psychiatrist. Once the child has had an assessment with a suitable paediatrician/child psychiatrist a referral can be made to the team if there is any doubt or concern about the diagnosis of autism. A referral can be made by any member of the assessment team or by the parents provided there is a paediatrician /child psychiatrist involved.

A referral to CAMHS can also be made if there are significant cultural or social reasons that make other methods of assessment difficult. This must be discussed with the Autism team directly

The waiting time to date has been short. Members of the initial assessment team are welcome to attend – an assessment with the parents' permission.

As of July 2008 there are new Medicare item numbers for autism **assessment** up to the age of 13 years. These item numbers give rebates on assessments by a speech pathologist, occupational therapist OR psychologist. A total of four rebates are allowed before the child's 13th birthday.

There are also new Medicare items that paediatricians and psychiatrists can use to complete the assessment and provide a report. So an assessment within the community is now more accessible than ever. Publicly funded services are limited and the use of private services will help resources to be targeted to those in greatest financial need.

For a private assessment with a paediatrician/child psychiatrist please note that the Medicare safety net for charges above the Medicare rebate and up to the Schedule fee is only \$400 if the child has a health care card (children with autism will generally qualify for health care card). So check with the paediatrician/child psychiatrist about their fees and complete the forms for the Medicare safety net.

In addition there are new Medicare item numbers for autism **treatment** up to the age of 15 years provided the child has been diagnosed before they are 13 years old. These item numbers give rebates on treatments by a speech pathologist, occupational therapist OR psychologist. A total of 20 rebates are allowed before the child's 15th birthday. The child must see a paediatrician or psychiatrist and be charged a specific Medicare item number to access these sessions. Details of the Medicare items are provided on page 12.

New Federal Funding for Autism in pre school children

Later this year pre school children with a formal diagnosis of autism will be able to access \$6,000 a year for two years before commencing school. (Children in remote country areas will get an additional \$2,000 per year – but no definition of remote country at present) Still do not know what date – funding start to become available 1st October but services then have to get organised and advisors have to be trained.

This funding will be given to recognized service providers on a panel of service providers. Tenders for becoming a service provider are currently being requested. To qualify the service provider has to show that they provide a multidisciplinary program.

The child will be initially referred to an Autism Advisor appointed by Autism Victoria. There will be 4 – 5 such advisors for the whole of Victoria but as yet these positions have not been advertised and the necessary qualifications for holding such a position are not clear.

The autism advisor will make sure that the child has the correct paper work to show that they are autistic – i.e. a speech pathology assessment, psychology assessment and a paediatric or child psychiatry report. We do not know specifically what reports are required and if this includes the whole spectrum or just autism.

Once the child has been approved by the autism advisor they will be referred to one of the service providers to commence therapy. This is worked out with the parents and the service provider depending on their preferences and the child's needs.

This is in addition to the State Government funded services.

Ideally the State Government service would be the same as the panel service e.g. Irabina are applying and could expand the child program using the funding. This does not have to be the case the child could use the State Government programs for one need and the panel programs for another.

Review of current situation with regards Medicare and autism

The situation is confusing and readjustment needs to be made to the Medicare schedule but we are stuck with the system as it stands.

Major issues are the training of professionals who can charge these fees and lack of availability of those who do know what to do.

This is only going to get worst when the new *Helping Children with Autism* package becomes available - parents of children 0 – 6 not at school will get \$6,000 each year for two years for early intervention therapy in addition to the State Government services.

The other issue is the increased pressure to diagnose autism rather than intellectual disability or developmental delay so children can access therapy.

Medicare items commonly used by paediatricians:

110 (rebate \$115.60) - initial attendance in a single course of therapy.

Can be billed for each new GP referral - no limits

116 (rebate \$58) - each attendance subsequent to the first

119 (rebate \$33)- each minor attendance subsequent to the first

No minimum time duration is necessary for the above items

122 (rebate \$140.6) like the 110 but conducted at patient's home

128 (rebate \$85) like the 116 but conducted at patient's home

131 (rebate \$61.20) like the 119 but conducted at patient's home

132 (rebate \$202.60) - 45 min attendance for an initial assessment of at least two problems (includes behaviour and development and both will be affected by autism) with production of a comprehensive treatment plan. Can be billed once in a 12-month period for each paediatrician.

133 (rebate \$101.45) - 20 min attendance subsequent to the above with a revision of the plans made. Can be billed twice in a 12-month

Minimum time limits for duration of consultation must be met.

Must bill a 132 before getting a rebate on 133

135 (rebate \$202.60) - 45 min assessment for a patient less than 13 years old with any form of PDD – have to do a comprehensive assessment for PDD with treatment and management plan for the GP and allied health professionals. A patient can only ever have one 135 in their life time so if another doctor has done one it cannot be claimed again. Without this assessment the child cannot access the 20 therapy sessions with allied health.

There are also items for case conferences if needed with other care providers of different disciplines.

Note that the rebate is only the Medicare amount that the patient will be able to claim.

The paediatrician usually charges above this rate. The paediatrician may charge the schedule fee and the gap will contribute towards the Medicare Safety net – which is just \$400 for a child with a health care card. Fees charged above the schedule fee cannot be reclaimed or add to the safety net so check what level you are being charged.

Medicare Items for allied health

Autism Assessments by Allied health

Speech pathologists and occupational therapists:

82005 and 82010 (rebate \$67.50) for a 50 minute assessment of autism in a child less than 13 yrs. Patient must have been billed by paediatrician/child psychiatrist

Psychologists:

82000 (rebate \$76.65) for a 50 min assessment of autism in a child less than 13 yrs. Patient must have been billed by a paediatrician/child psychiatrist

Autism Treatment by Allied health

20 sessions of speech pathology, occupational therapy OR psychology can be billed before the child turn 15 yrs. Any combination can be used but the total number of rebates will only be 20 and only once in the child's lifetime.

Speech pathologists and occupational therapists:

82020 and 82025 (rebate \$67.50) for a 30 min individual therapy sessions in a child less than 15yrs with PDD. Child must have been billed a135 or before their 13th birthday – not necessarily by the doctor making the referral.

Psychologists:

82015 (rebate \$76.65) for a 30 min individual therapy sessions in a child less than 15 yrs with PDD. Child must have been billed a 135 before their 13th birthday – not necessarily by the doctor making the referral.

Enhanced Primary Care plan

Treatment is also available by a GP referral under the EPC plan – this gives 5 sessions total a year with a rebate of \$47.85 for a service that lasts at least 20mins with any of the following:

Audiology, occupational therapy, physiotherapy, psychology, speech pathology, podiatry and some others

Mental Health Care Plan (Better outcomes)

Children with chronic conditions such as autism who have mental health issues e.g. anxiety can access psychology and occupational therapy under this plan. (which suggests the autism sessions may be better used by the speech pathologist)

12 sessions in total per calendar year are available and additional ones if there are exceptional circumstances. The rebates are higher for psychologists.

To access these services the child must have been billed a 110,116,119, 122,128 or a 131. So cannot be referred after a 132, 133 or 135 only.

Psychology rebates under Mental Health Plan:

These sessions may be: individual lasting 20 – 50 minutes (rebate \$76.65), lasting more than 50 minutes (rebate \$112.45). There are higher rebates for these two types of therapy in the home \$95.75 and \$131.55 respectively and also 60 min group sessions of 6 – 10 people rebate \$28.6 per person

Occupational Therapy rebates under Mental Health Plan:

These sessions may be: individual lasting 20 – 50 minutes (rebate \$47.85), lasting more than 50 minutes (rebate \$67.50). There are higher rebates for these two types of therapy in the home \$67.50 and \$87 respectively and also 60 min group sessions of 6 – 10 people rebate \$17.20 per person

The psychologist and occupational therapist must be registered by Medicare as meeting the credentials for provision of this service. So need to check this as not all therapists dealing in early intervention especially OT may have the credentials for mental health provision.

Note social workers can also be accessed under this plan

**Only rarely will the Medicare rebate cover the cost charged by the allied health therapist so check how much you are being charged a session before starting therapy.
Private health care funds may also give rebates.**

**EASTERN HEALTH CAMHS TERTIARY REFERRALS
(for children in the Eastern Health area – see list of suburbs)**

If there is any doubt about the diagnosis by any member of an assessment team or by the parents then the child should be referred to Eastern Health CAMHS for a second opinion. A referral to CAMHS can also be made if there are cultural or social reasons that make other methods of assessment difficult.

All children must have a paediatrician or child psychiatrist in the community who can provide follow on care.

To date the waiting list is short. A member of the initial assessment team should make the referral, which should include copies of all available and relevant reports.

Members of the initial assessment team are welcome to attend the assessment with the parents' permission.
